Outwood Primary Academy Homework Planners

Dear Parent/Carer,

Your child has been given an Outwood Primary Academy homework planner in their book bag today.

The planner contains a wealth of information for both parents and children including:

- Safeguarding information
- Academy expectations and praise
- Overview of consequences
- Uniform expectations
- Overview of Praising Stars
- Literacy and Maths key curriculum information
- Homework diary including weekly reading log

Pages 6 and 11 refer to the academy's acceptable use policy and home academy agreement. These pages **require a parent signature** to acknowledge the positive relationship between school and home.

Pages 7-10 contain the privacy notice which explains how your child's data is used in line with the Trust's GDPR data protection policy and **requires a parent signature**.

On Monday, your child will complete the word and number of the week. Please take every opportunity to discuss and explore these. They will also complete their spelling test and times table test on a weekly basis so that you can provide support where needed and celebrate their achievements.

It is expected that your child reads for a minimum of 20 minutes, 3 times a week. This is to support your child's development and foster their love for reading. Please ensure you initial the weekly reading log after your child has read to an adult. This will be monitored by the school.

We hope this planner provides a useful point of reference and homework reminder for both children and parents.
