VICTORIAN DAY – YEAR 1



As part of next term's topic on The Victorians, we have arranged an exciting themed day around The Victorians to take place in school on Wednesday 22nd June 2022. The day will include a visitor from the past coming into school to talk to the children in the role of a Victorian woman who lived in Wakefield in the 1800s called Ann Dixon. She will be talking to the children about her home and family and will be bringing many artefacts from her home for the children to see.

We ask for a voluntary contribution of £3.80 towards the cost of this workshop. It is important to stress that in the event of an inadequate number of parental contributions it will not be possible for the workshop to take place and it will be cancelled. Please pay all voluntary contributions before Monday 6th June 2022.

Payments must be paid via Parentpay and the payment will be showing when you log on. For parents who have yet to set up an account, an activation letter will be sent home today with your child. We would also like children to dress as a Victorian child on the day. If your child would like to take part - **Girls** wore dresses and pinafores to school, with an apron over the top to protect their dresses from stains, while **boys** wore trousers and a shirt, and sometimes a waistcoat. This is optional, children can wear their school uniform if they prefer.
