Dear Families,

We wanted to take this opportunity to thank you for your continued support of the academy and the trust at the end of what has been another fantastic yet challenging academic year. I would like to reiterate how grateful we are for the levels of support from yourselves. We are looking forward to even greater levels of collaboration in the coming year.

As we look forward to the new academic year, we do see signs that a more 'normal' school year may be on the horizon. We will take a cautious approach to this - ensuring that as we move into more familiar territory, we do so with appropriate controls and procedures to always ensure we are compliant with government guidance.

In readiness for the new academic year, we would like to remind you of our expectations for school uniform:

- Purple sweatshirt or cardigan (with school logo)
- White polo shirt or white school shirt
- Grey skirt, trousers or school shorts
- Grey socks  
or tights
- Black shoes (plain only, no  
trainers or boots)

Summer uniform (purple dress, white socks, black shoes) may be worn until October half term.

Children also require a PE kit consisting of:

- Purple t-shirt (with school logo)
- Black shorts
- Black socks and trainers

Could we also take this opportunity to remind families that it is the trust policy that jewellery should not be worn by children in the academy. This includes the wearing of earrings. If you are hoping to have your child's ears pierced then the summer holiday is a good time for this as it allows a long period of time for the healing to take place. If there are any medical reasons that you need to discuss, please do not hesitate to contact the academy.

We have attached to this letter a copy of next year's term dates. Could we please ask that when planning your holidays you take note of these. As is the national policy and our own policy – all holidays in term time will be unauthorised unless there are exceptional circumstances. Holidays in term time may result in a fixed penalty notice. We can confirm that next year the academy is closed to pupils on:

- Oct Half Term - 25th - 29th Oct 2021
- Christmas Holiday - 20th Dec 2021 - 3rd Jan 2022
- February Half Term - 21st - 25th February 2022
- Easter Holidays - 11th April - 22nd April 2022
- May Half Term - 30th May - 3rd June 2022
- Summer Holidays - 25th July - 5th September 2022
