As part of next term's topic on The Victorians, we have arranged an exciting themed day around The Victorians to take place in school on Wednesday 16th June. The day will include a visitor from the past coming into school to talk to the children in role a Victorian woman who lived in Wakefield in the 1800's called Ann Dixon. She will be talking to the children about her home and family and will be bringing many artefacts from her home for the children to see.

The cost of the day has been subsidised by school but we are asking for a £4.00 contribution from parents towards the cost of the day.

As visits/trips have only just been given the go ahead to start again, we decided that this was the best way to deliver a fun day to the children to enhance their learning.
