

Dear Families,

Following on from the last Parent Survey, we would like to outline how we have responded to your feedback.

- In September, we hosted 'Meet the Teacher' meetings for you to get to know your child's teacher for the academic year.
- We have hosted parent workshops for phonics and maths, where you got to see your child's learning in action. There will be a 'writing' workshop in the Summer term!
- Turning Point workshops and Family Links training have been successful and have run at regular times through this year.
- As well as pupil surveys and SLT pupil voice sessions, we have also asked our Academy Council of governors to take pupil-voice from children regarding bullying and behaviour, and have listened and responded to children's feedback.
- 'Expressions' has been introduced as a more efficient method of communication to families.
- All children have access to Google Classroom to support their learning in school and home.
- Key dates are communicated half-termly, giving you the knowledge of forthcoming events in school.
- We have a range of home-learning apps, such as Times Tables Rockstars, Emile and Accelerated Reader for children to access.
- We have strengthened our community relationships, and children have regular visits to the church and library, and take part in litter picking and road safety activities.
- Continuing our work with the Family Hub.
- We have set up the '[Primary Learning Website](#)', which details what your children are learning in school in each half term.
- All children have the opportunity for at least one visit to enrich the curriculum.
