Dear Parents/ Carers,

As already communicated via text, we have taken the decision today to close the school due to the deterioration of the weather overnight and the forecast that snow will continue falling heavily throughout the morning. There will be a further 2 live sessions at 11am and then at 1pm and then tasks set for children to complete independently.
