

Dear Parents/ Carers,

We are pleased to inform you that we have booked an overnight stay camping experience for the children in Year 5! The camp has been booked with The Outdoors People. They provide Tipi style tents for the children to sleep in and complete a range of activities with the children.

At the overnight camp, the children will work together to put up their tents, play energetic games with our giant Kin Ball, toast marshmallows, sing songs around the campfire, and have an amazing night under the stars with their friends. During the day, we have a huge range of exciting educational activities and challenges for the children to choose from. Children might learn to make fires, take part in the bush-tucker challenge, cook over an open fire, learn basic first aid, purify muddy water into tasty hot chocolate, and much more.

We would like the children to be in school for the usual time of 8.45am for registration on **Thursday 27th June 2024**. We will be staying at school until the following day (**Friday 28th June 2024**) when children will leave school at the end of the day. **Food will be provided for the duration of the stay.**

The cost of the overnight camp and two activities days (including food) is £50.00. We are asking for a contribution of **£40.00** and school will be contributing £10.00 also. Please can parents pay this contribution by Friday 7th June 2024. You will be able to pay this in £10.00 instalments should you wish.

We would love every child to experience this, so if you are having any difficulties making the payment or concerns about your child staying overnight please speak to Mr Jackson or any member of staff who can help. This is open to all the children in Year 5. If there is a shortfall of Year 5 pupils however, it will be opened up to another year group to help us cover the costs.
