Many children took part in extra-curricular clubs last half term, and these clubs will run until the second-to-last week this half term.





Certificates and badges for 100% attendance

4 X Full Half term 100% attendance	Silver Award badge and Certificate
6 X Full Half terms 100% attendance (a full year 100% attendance)	Gold Award badge, certificate and £10 voucher

- Certificates and letters homes to families congratulating them on improved attendance
- £10 draw every week for pupils with 100% for that week.
- Weekly Celebration Attendance assemblies
- Weekly class award for the class with the highest attendance for that week.

How we support families to improve attendance

- Keep families update through a series of letters
- Hold 'Wellbeing Meeting' with families to fully understand any barriers that school can support with to improve attendance
- Carry out home visits
- Pupil 'Check In' with Attendance and Safeguarding Officer
- Initiate Fast Track support for pupils with an attendance of 95% or below
- Year 5 and Year 6 pupils will begin to take ownership of their attendance by keeping a weekly log in their Planners
