

Dear Parents/Carers,

On Wednesday 6th March, children will be dissecting a lamb's heart and lungs. This will enhance our science curriculum, bring anatomy to life and provide a unique learning experience for children. In the past, children have found this session extremely beneficial and gained a greater depth of understanding of the organs and how they function.

We intend for the children to have the opportunity to explore the heart and lung organs from a lamb as this is close in comparison to a human's heart and lungs. This will be a beneficial way to have a real-life experience in relation to their science learning.

A risk assessment has been carried out and the few precautions that need to be taken have been put into place.

The children will be given an opportunity to handle the tissue and inspect the heart if they wish to do so. They will be wearing disposable gloves and aprons. In line with the risk assessment, if your child wishes to remove themselves from the lesson, for whatever reason, arrangements will be put into place.
