Scarborough Trip

As part of the Year 6 leavers celebrations we have been able to secure a trip to the seaside. We feel that this is a perfect opportunity to celebrate the outstanding work, which the children have done this year.

The trip to Scarborough will take place on Friday 14th July 2023

We would like the children to be in school for no later than 8.15am for registration and then we will leave school at 8.30am promptly. We are expecting our return to be around 3.30 pm.

We ask for a non-refundable amount of £27.30 to reserve your child's place. This will not be refunded if you cancel your child's place on the trip.

The trip money must be paid in full by Friday 30th June 2023 along with any other outstanding money owed to school i.e. Breakfast Club, Dinner or outstanding Trip money from previous trips. If any outstanding monies are owed the Executive Principal reserves the right to refuse your child's attendance on this trip. If not enough contributions are made then the trip will be cancelled.

Children should wear clothes suitable for a trip to the coast in summer. This should include clothes suitable for a sunny day on the beach (hat, shorts, T-shirt as well as sun cream) as well as a lightweight coat, in case it's a wet day. They will also need a set of spare clothes to change into at the end of the day.

We will be fundraising over the next few weeks so that the children will be able to buy lunch from the fish and chip shop. If they do not want to eat something from the fish and chips shop, then they may bring a packed lunch (no glass bottles, cans, or fizzy drinks) or, if your child is eligible for free school meals, and requires a packed lunch from school, please indicate on the slip below.

Children can bring a maximum of £15.00 cash into school to spend during the day if they want to. Please note the children will be responsible for their own money.

All payments need to be paid via Parentpay. Please also provide permission and an update on Medical Information.
