Dear Parents / Carers

As part of the OPA Diploma, Y6 will be immersing themselves into life as a child evacuee during WW2 on Friday 28th May. They will carry out a number of tasks throughout the day to allow them to experience what a day could have been like. The children are also invited to dress like children did in the 1940s if they would like to do so. This is not a necessity as children can just attend school in their usual uniform as normal if they would prefer.

Suggestions on how dressing as an evacuee may look are as follows:
Children should wear shoes, boots or wellington boots (not trainers), Woollen jumper or cardigan (not sweatshirt), Shirt or blouse (not t-shirt).
Boys should wear a cap or woollen hat and they should have knee-length trousers. Girls should wear a beret, headscarf or woollen hat and a knee-length dress or skirt.
