Updated Christmas Information

Christmas Performances – Performances will take place over multiple days, starting on Wednesday 8th and ending on Wednesday 15th December. Each class will be performing in the Hall and we will **only** be allowing 2 adults per each child. We aim to start <u>all</u> performances by 9.15am each day, the Hall will be open from 9.00am for parents to 'sign in' and refreshments will be available. We will issue every child with 2 tickets today and these must be shown for entry (please note these are not transferable).

To ensure the performances are as safe a possible and able to go ahead I am asking that all parents follow the below:

- We ask all parents attending the performance to take a LFD test prior to coming into school. If this is positive then please do not attend the performance.
- If you have a positive covid result and are isolating or are unwell with any symptoms please **do not attend** the performance.
- All parents **must** wear a face covering (unless proof of exemption is shown) before coming into school.
- Sanitise your hands on entry to the hall it will be available by the entrance.
- We will enter through the hall and sign in as we do. Queue on the cones (maintain a social distance) and be patient. There will be a seat for everyone.
- We ask that you **do not** move the chairs as they will be placed to support distancing.
- The windows will be open to allow good ventilation so wear a coat.
- The nursery performance will be in Nursery so please enter through your normal doors.
- Finally, **do not record or take photos** at the performance. This is very important as we have children in school who are not allowed for safety reasons. We will take photos and put them on the Google classrooms.

Please note - All plans are subject to any changes in Local Authority, Government guidance and also the numbers of cases within our school community. If I feel there is heightened risk I will have no choice but to make the performances virtual. I hope this does not happen but please support us if it does.
